- From March to November 2026, Waterfront Park will come alive with [Alicia Egger's](#) monumental **Now or Never**, a bold public art installation featuring two towering 17.5-foot-tall, 40-foot-long billboards with opposing "Now" and "Never" messages. Designed to spark curiosity and conversation, the striking work explores urgency, polarization, change and the possibilities of finding common ground.

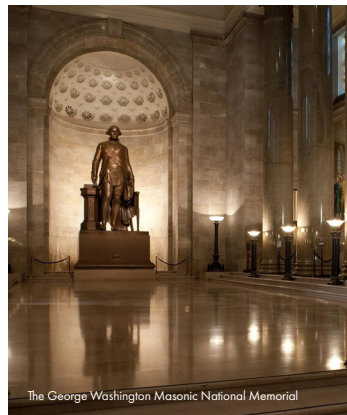
